



outcomes of the 2006 ENCWP symposium teaching writing and translation in a multilingual context (15-17 november 2006, prague)

participation

the symposium was attended by the representatives of the following member institutions: *vienna poetry academy, josef skvorecky literary academy, orivesi college of arts, helicon society for the advancement of poetry in israel, university of gothenburg (literary composition), university of leipzig (german literary institute), university of hildesheim, swiss literary institute.*

the invited guests included alexandra büchler, director of the *literature across frontiers programme* (uk), and dana kalinová, managing director of the *svet knihy/bookworld* company (czech republic).

co-operation with bookworld and literature across frontiers

it was decided that, starting in 2007, the encwp symposium would take place at prague's bookworld book fair and literary festival (at the beginning of may). the next encwp symposium will include the conference *literature and multimedia* (on 2 may 2007) organized jointly by encwp and literature across frontiers, and workshops and readings at bookworld (3-6 may 2007).
